Dear Long Grove Residents,

We are contacting you as an HOA representative or as an individual who has expressed an interest in the issues regarding roads in the Village of Long Grove.

As you know, Long Grove's unique history of development resulted in a mixture of private and public local roads and thoroughfares. This situation has presented significant challenges to developing an approach with broad community support to pay for the maintenance of the roads in the Village, especially in light of rapidly escalating costs for paving and the Village's limited sources of revenue.

In pursuit of a collaborative approach, the Village will conduct three workshops to engage the community, share perspectives, and explore potential options for structure of an approach. The content of the three workshops will be essentially identical; multiple workshops will be held both to help ensure all interested parties are provided an opportunity to participate and to help ensure that the size of the workshops are conducive to open dialogue.

We encourage you to select one of the workshops to attend. If you are unable to participate in any of the workshops, we encourage you to send a representative. The workshops will be held at the Long Grove Village Hall (3110 Old McHenry Road) at the following times:
